

Fact Sheet for Election of Board Members Region 18 Education Service Center

Two positions on the Board of Directors of Region 18 Education Service Center will be filled by candidates elected by the Boards of Trustees of school districts in the region. Each member of the local boards will have a ballot. All ballots will be canvassed. This year, the board positions to be filled are as follows:

- <u>Place 5</u> is designated as the confines of the following school district(s):
 Alpine, Balmorhea, Buena Vista, Culberson County-Allamoore, Fort Davis,
 Iraan-Sheffield, Marathon, Marfa, Presidio, San Vicente, Terlingua, Terrell
 County, or Valentine.
- Place 7 is designated as the confines of the following school district(s):
 Andrews or Monahans.

Persons who live within the confines of the districts in Places 5 and 7, and who are eligible candidates for the Board of Directors of Region 18 Education Service Center, may obtain filing forms directly from the administrative offices of the school districts or from the Executive Director's office of the Service Center. However, candidates must submit the filing form/affidavit during regular business hours at the Executive Director's office in person or by certified mail between February 1 and February 20.

According to TEC Chapter 8.003(b) and TAC Chapter 53.1 (b) the following rules of eligibility apply:

Term of Office:

- A member of a regional education service center (RESC) Board of Directors shall be elected for a three-year term. The term of office shall begin June 1.
- 2. If a vacancy occurs due to death or resignation of a member of an RESC Board of Directors, a 30-day period shall elapse, after notice has been given to the board chair, before the vacancy is filled.
 - At the beginning of the 30-day period, notice of any vacancy shall be given to the president of the Board of Trustees and the superintendent of each school district in the education service center region and shall be posted in appropriate locations.

4. A vacancy for the un-expired term of a member of an RESC Board of Directors shall be filled by appointment by the remaining board members.

Election Procedures:

- 1. A member of an RESC Board of Directors must be a United States citizen, at least 18 years of age, and a resident of that education service center region. He or she may not be engaged professionally in education or be a member of a board of any educational agency or institution. The eligibility of an RESC board member under this subsection is determined by the requirements specified in this subsection, as they existed on the date the RESC board member was elected or appointed to office.
- 2. A member of an RESC Board of Directors shall be elected by the boards of trustees of the school districts in the educational service center region.
- 3. Any eligible person wishing to seek election to an RESC Board of Directors shall file at the headquarters of that RESC in person or by certified mail between February 1 and February 20. No filing fee shall be required. Each RESC Board of Directors shall adopt policies concerning filing procedures.
- 4. By February 1, notice of the time and place for filing shall be posted in appropriate locations and submitted to appropriate newspapers in the education service center region for publication and to the superintendent of each school district in the education service center region.
- 5. A ballot shall be developed and submitted to the Board of Trustees of each school district in the education service center region by March 1. Placement on the ballot shall be determined by drawing. Each member of the Board of Trustees of each school district in the education service center region shall have one vote for each vacancy on the RESC Board of Directors. Completed ballots shall be returned to the chair of the RESC Board of Directors by April 5. The RESC Board of Directors shall canvass the ballots at its next regularly scheduled or special meeting, but not later than May 31.

- and determine the winner by a plurality of the votes cast. In the event of a tie, the names of the candidates who have tied shall be resubmitted to the Board of Trustees of each school district in the education service center region. Notification will be transmitted to the local districts by April 20, 2025.
- 6. The provisions described in subsection (b) (2) and (5) of this section do not apply if all positions in the election are uncontested. In the event of an uncontested election, the RESC Board of Directors may determine that no election will be held. The RESC Board of Directors must make this determination prior to March 1. If, due to an uncontested election, the RESC Board of Directors determines that an election should not be held, the RESC board shall declare the unopposed candidates elected to office. The RESC executive director shall notify the Commissioner of Education of the results of an election, whether contested or uncontested.
