

# Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

The County of Jeff Davis will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 5.80 percent (percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of rollback tax rate or effective tax calculated under Tax Code, Chapter 26). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on 9-11-17 at 9:00 am at Jeff Davis Courthouse

The second public hearing will be held on 9-18-17 at 9:00am at Jeff Davis Courthouse.

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$.55562 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$ 639.48
